10	Mass	Comparing mass of different objects, conversion of kilogram into grams, recognize units of mass ,use standard units of mass to measure and record mass of variety of objects, addition and subtraction of mass
11	Capacity	Definition, conversion of litres into millilitres, compare capacity using non-standard and standard units, addition and
